WHAT: Taylor Blvd/New Cut Rd (KY-1865) is a high-crash corridor currently being studied for safety improvements. The study will include crash and traffic analyses and make recommendations on construction funding and phasing.

WHO: Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC), through engineering consulting firm Burgess & Niple. Funding is provided by KYTC's Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP).

WHEN: The study is expected to be completed by Summer 2024.

WHERE: Taylor Blvd/New Cut Rd (KY-1865) between the Watterson Expressway (I-264) and the Gene Snyder Freeway (KY-841).

WHY: Reduce fatal and serious injury crashes.
